- ***Continent 7* Film Screening:** Film screening of National Geographic's *Continent 7* in the auditorium of the National Museum of Wildlife Art. This featured film is produced by National Geographic and made possible by the efforts of Jackson Hole Wild, a non-profit organization dedicated to promoting public awareness and stewardship of wildlife and wildlife habitat and appreciation for the wonders of science through the innovative use of media.

\*Description: Antarctica is the harshest place on Earth. The temperature drops to more than 100 degrees below zero, winds gust over 200mph, crevasses big enough to swallow trucks hide beneath a thin sheet of snow, storms bury entire buildings in snow and ice, and despite all that frozen water, the air is as dry as the Sahara in places. It's a place where humans aren't meant to survive. Yet... there is a community rugged individuals whose work puts them in the path of all these challenges. They make this place hospitable, and not just for themselves, but for others. These scientists and the community play a vital role in many urgent fields of science, from climate change to studies of glacier movement, active volcanoes and the search and tagging of marine megafauna that calls this ice home.

- **GTNP Photo Expedition:** Half-day tour of Grand Teton National Park (GTNP) by JH EcoTour Adventures, lasting a few hours. You'll discover Jackson Hole's wildlife hotspots from the comfort of a 4x4 safari style vehicle. Let one of the guides become your wildlife encyclopedia and local expert as you zoom in with your own camera or gaze out into the mountains and lowlands with the high quality binoculars and spotting scopes. They're happy to engage with you about anything that peaks your interest, but their passion and expertise cater towards local ecology, animal behavior, animal adaptations during winter, snow science, geology, and cultural history. Non strenuous hikes are included, if desired, to educate you about the smaller wonders of this special place and to open your senses to this unique glaciated landscape.
- **Art Association of JH Public Art Tour:** Public Art Director will guide participants on a one hour tour of approximately 7 large-scale installations. Participants will learn about the artist's process and relevant stories behind each installation.
- **Ben Folds Performance:** Solo at his grand piano and anchored as always by songs - classic and current - this show is about music, storytelling, audience interaction and improvisation with a stage full of instruments.
