



ANNUAL SUMMARY – 2020

The Center strived to keep the campus active during the first year of the COVID-19 pandemic with virtual and livestreamed events and collaborations with Resident organizations. In 2020, operations at The Center ran regularly until the middle of March, when programs and events were cancelled or postponed due to the pandemic. The Center engaged in a collaborative fundraising effort along with Resident organizations to ensure Resident organizations were able to pay sublease rent. This collaborative effort raised enough funds to cover 40% of all Resident organization rent in 2020. In collaboration with Resident organizations and others, The Center campus was active for 122 event days in 2020, excluding theater technical days, for a wide variety of events onstage, events livestreamed virtually through our website, events outside in The Center Park and events throughout the campus. Including theater technical days, The Center was activated 181 days. (This count excludes classes offered by Resident organizations in Resident organization leased spaces.)

In 2015, the Board of Directors of Center for the Arts adopted the following mission statement: To connect our creative community by providing a dedicated campus, supporting excellent programming, and nurturing a collaborative spirit. It is The Center's vision to make artistic experience central to Jackson Hole by embracing the values of stewardship, excellence, inclusion, creativity, and respect.

The Center is a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit organization. Any operating surplus is directed to operating costs, including depreciation.

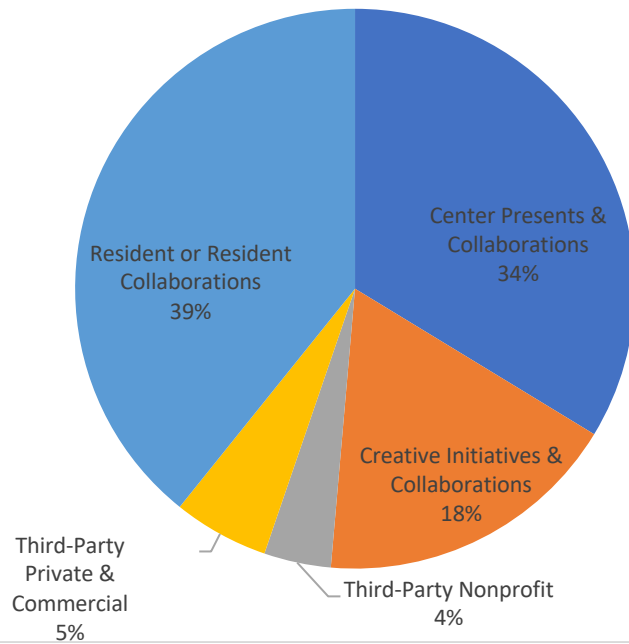

THE CENTER CAMPUS EVENTS

- The Center was open 273 days.
- The Center Campus was used for 93 events over 181 days.
- The Center hosted or co-hosted 60 events over 93 days, through Creative Initiatives, Center Presents, and collaborations with Resident and other organizations. This represented 51% of total days activated throughout the year.
- Resident organizations hosted or co-hosted 20 events over 71 days, which represented 39% of total days activated throughout the year.
- Third-party rentals (including rentals by nonprofit, for-profit, commercial and private entities) accounted for 17 days of activity, or 10% of overall campus usage. Of that, 7 days of activity were related to events hosted or co-hosted by nonprofit organizations and 10 days of activity were hosted or co-hosted by commercial or private entities. These separate categories represented 4% and 6% of total days activated, respectively.
- As per the conditions of The Center's lease with the Town and County, the total number of private commercial events may not exceed 10% of total events during the fiscal year. In 2020, there were 9 private profitable event days, or 5% of total activity, were held on campus.
- The conditions of The Center's lease require that the total number of private profitable plus private non-profitable events not exceed 15% of total number of events. The Center was host to 9 days of private commercial events, and 1 private and non-profitable event, which represents 6% of all events days on The Center Campus.
- The Center Campus hosted and/or virtually livestreamed 63 Free events in 2020.
- The average ticket price for paid ticketed events ticketed through The Center Box Office was \$27.
- 6,830 tickets were sold through The Center Box Office in 2020.
- The Center Theater seats 525 people.
- The Center Theater Lobby is 2,500 sq. ft.

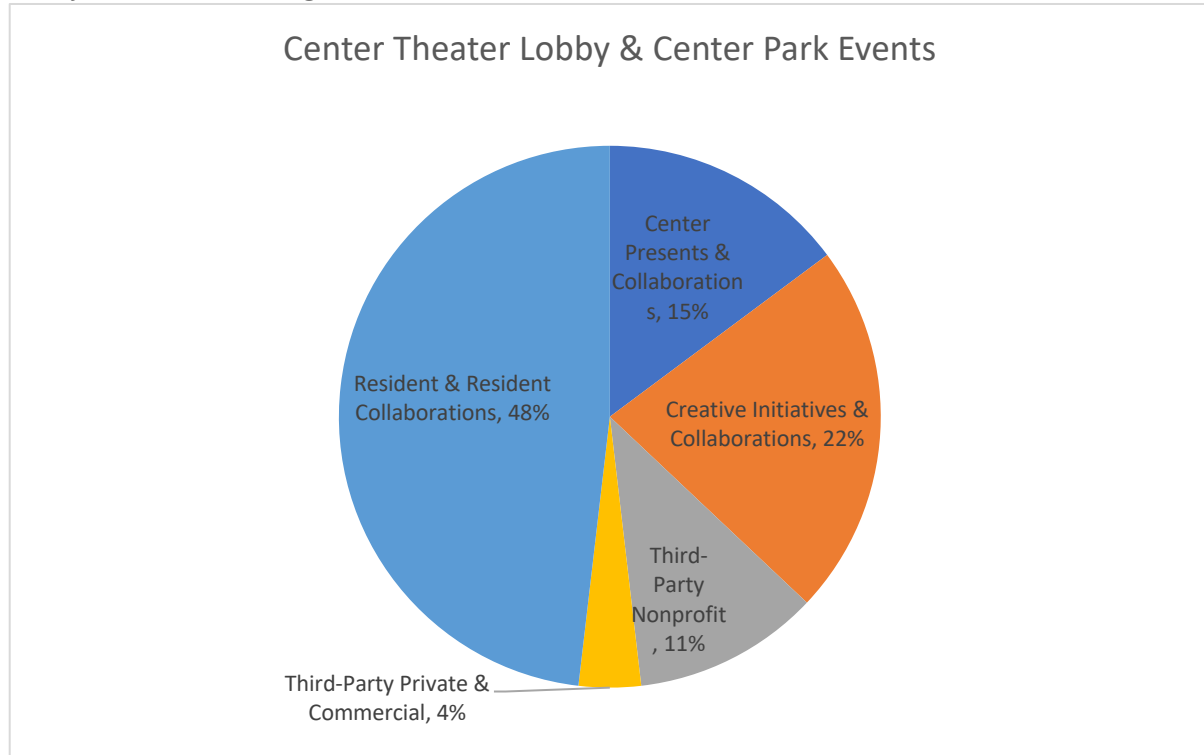

CENTER RESIDENT LEASE RATES

The 2020 average annual lease rate was \$24.40 per built square foot for administrative space, \$16.75 per built square foot for studio and classroom space, and \$8.08 per built square foot for storage space. During this first year of the COVID-19 pandemic, The Center engaged in a collaborative fundraising effort along with Resident organizations to ensure Resident organizations were able to pay sublease rent. This collaborative effort raised enough funds to cover 40% of all Resident organization rent in 2020.

The following is a list of Residents and accompanying square footage they occupy at The Center. This list reflects lease rates as outlined in Resident leases and does not include details on rent relief provided through collaborative fundraising efforts.

Residents occupy and rent 32,642 square feet of The Center. Residents pay on average \$17.74 per square foot for occupied space. Additionally, Residents have access to roughly 25,753 square feet of common areas. Common areas do not include the theater, lobby, dressing rooms, costume shop, and music rooms. When common areas are factored into the overall square footage available, Residents' rates average \$9.91 per square foot.

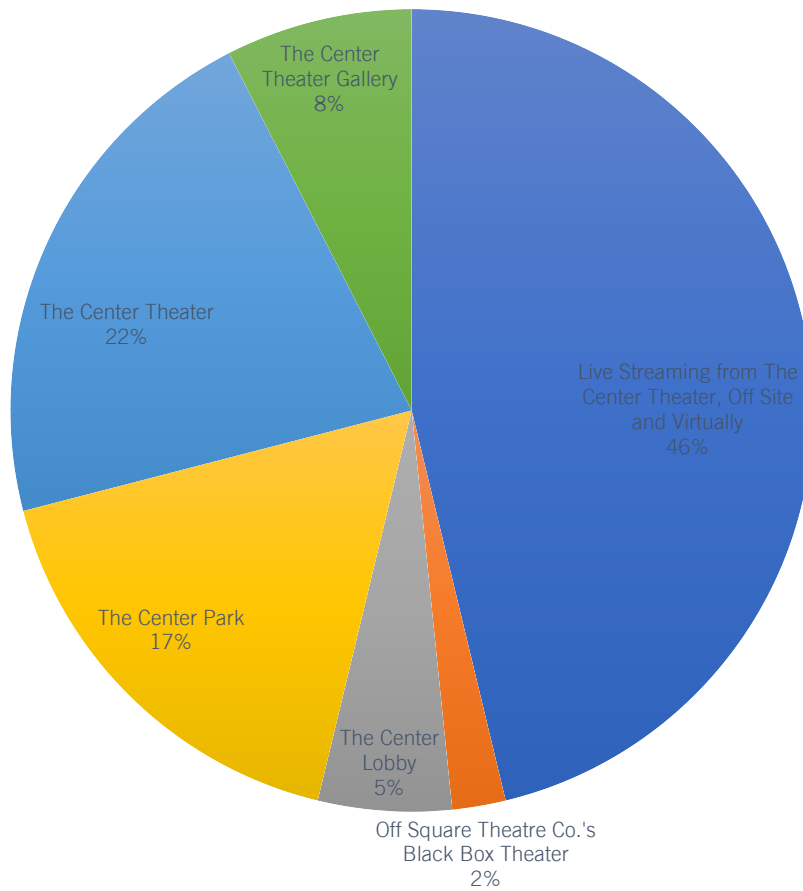

We did not host the Annual Center Benefit in 2020.

THE CENTER'S FINANCES

THE CENTER FUNDRAISING HISTORY

Early efforts to build The Center began in the late 1990's. The Center was constructed in two phases; the Arts and Educational Pavilion opened in 2005, and The Center Theater opened in 2007.

To build each wing, The Center was successful in raising \$31.1M in gifts and pledges. \$12M for the education wing and \$18.1M for the theater. Several of these major gifts were pledged over multiple years, however, and during the second phase in 2007 it was necessary to borrow \$6.7M to meet short-term obligations. Most of the multi-year gifts received eliminated \$4.7M of the \$6.7M debt. Unfortunately, due to the economic recession in 2008, several major pledges were either reduced or cancelled. Because of this, The Center was unable to repay the loan in full and was left with \$2.5M in debt. In 2014 a concerted effort was launched to pay it down and just \$594,000 remained at the end of December 2020.

The Center has raised substantial monies to fund our operations. Lease income from Residents and Third-Party rental fees fall short of meeting our budgetary needs. Contributed income is essential to sustaining our financial health. To date, we have raised \$42,516,451 as outlined below.

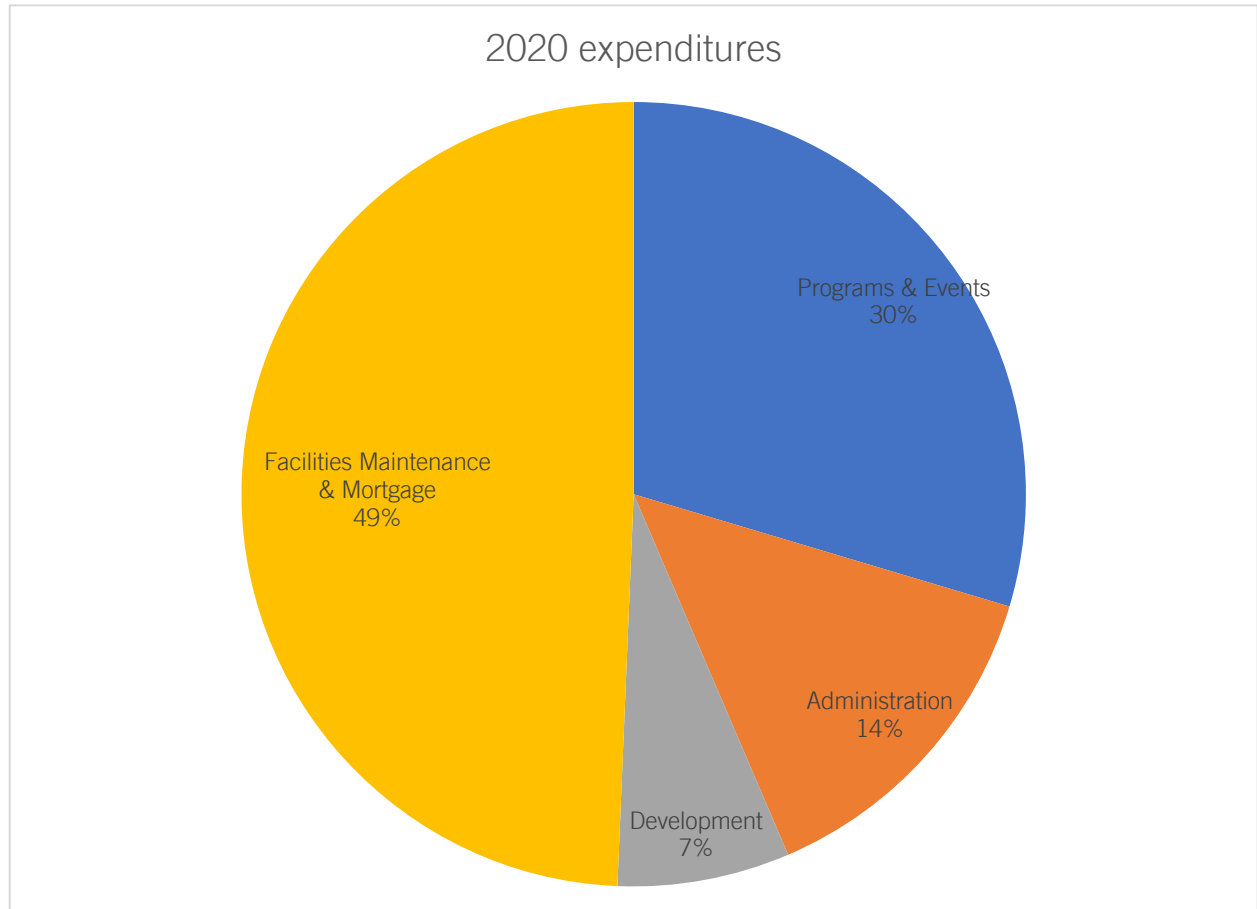

The Center's spending falls into 4 categories: Programs & Events, Facilities Maintenance, & Mortgage, Administrative, and Development. In 2020, The Center's total spending was \$2,728,147.



SUMMARY OF CAPITAL DEBT

Every year, The Center makes a concerted effort to pay down our capital debt. At the end of 2020, the debt has been reduced to \$594,000 from its high of \$6.7M.

SUMMARY OF NEIGHBOR RELATIONS
