THE CENTER CAMPUS EVENTS

- The Center was open 345 days.
- The Center Campus was activated 282 days with 158 distinct performances or events. The remaining 124 days include rehearsal and technical days.
- As per the conditions of The Center’s lease with the Town and County, the total number of private profitable events may not exceed 10% of total events during the fiscal year. In 2021, there were 11 days used by commercial entities, or 3.9% of total activity.
- The conditions of The Center’s lease require that the total number of private profitable plus private not-for-profit events not exceed 15% of total number of events. The Center was host to 11 days of private commercial events, and 3 private not-for-profit events, which represents 4.9% of all event days on The Center Campus.
- The Center Campus livestreamed 36 free events in 2021.
- The average ticket price for paid ticketed events ticketed through The Center Box Office was \$39.
- There were 10,275 tickets sold through The Center Box Office for in-person events.
- Approximately 28,000 patrons visited The Center for events throughout the year. This does not include patrons who visited campus for Resident classes and education programs.
- About 400 livestream tickets were sold in 2021. In addition, we had approximately 30,000 viewers for free livestream events.

Knit the Center was a collaborative yarn bombing project at Center for the Arts this winter to beautify and cozy up public spaces on campus! It covered several different areas of outdoor space at The Center from December 2020 through March 2021.

Bland Hoke: Ripple

Ripple was displayed along the northern parking lot fence from September 2020 until August 2021. Hoke's process is a direct response to places and people, marked by a true understanding of contemporary design and a signature resourcefulness, courtesy of his Western roots.

Sam Dowd: Glimpse

Sam Dowd, with his MFA in ceramics, displayed quirky ceramics with faces on The Center Sculpture pad located at the building's Northeast corner from September 2020 until August 2021.

Dancers' Workshop Clamshell Stage Classes

Following Grand Teton Music Festivals early July concerts, Dancers' Workshop took advantage of keeping the Clamshell stage set up at the South end of The Center Park. For the rest of July, they held various classes, workshops, and informal showings for dancers.

Chalk it Up!

In conjunction with Art Association of Jackson Hole, visiting artist, Chris Carlson, decorated the sidewalks south of the building along with workshop students from August 9-12, 2021.

Barbara Gentry: Time

Barbara Gentry's piece is called Time and is made with mild steel and river rock. The sculpture was invited to be placed on The Center Sculpture Pad in the fall of 2021 as part of the Creative in Residence project led by Agnes Bourne.

Residents occupy and rent 33,100 square feet of The Center. Residents pay on average \$17.81 per square foot for occupied space (before rent relief is applied). Additionally, Residents have access to 25,753 square feet of common areas. Common areas do not include the theater, lobby, dressing rooms,

and costume shop. When common areas are factored into the overall square footage available, Residents' rates average \$10.05 per square foot, before rent relief is applied.

THE CENTER'S FINANCES

Fundraising History

Early efforts to build The Center began in the late 1990s. The Center was constructed in two phases; the Arts and Educational Pavilion opened in 2005, and The Center Theater opened in 2007.

To build each wing, The Center was successful in raising \$31.1M in gifts and pledges. \$12M for the education wing and \$19.1M for the theater. Several of these major gifts were pledged over multiple years, however, and during the second phase in 2007 it was necessary to borrow \$6.7M to meet short-term obligations. Most of the multi-year gifts received eliminated \$4.7M of the \$6.7M debt. Unfortunately, due to the economic recession in 2008, several major pledges were either reduced or cancelled. Because of this, The Center was unable to repay the loan in full and was left with \$2.5M in debt. In 2014 a concerted effort was launched to pay it down and just \$578,000 remained at the end of December 2021.

The Center has raised substantial monies to fund our operations. Lease income from Residents and Third-Party rental fees fall short of meeting our budgetary needs. Contributed income is essential to sustaining our financial health. To date, we have raised \$44,619,984 as outlined below.
