



ANNUAL SUMMARY – 2018

The following document provides a snapshot of The Center campus in the calendar year 2018. In collaboration with Residents and others, The Center campus was activated 148 event days, excluding theater technical days, for a wide variety of events. Including theater technical days, The Center campus was activated for 169 event days. This count excludes classes offered on campus. Approximately 14,000 students enjoyed 1,200 classes, seminars, rehearsals and workshops hosted primarily by Residents on The Center Campus during the year.

In 2015, the Board of Directors of Center for the Arts adopted the following mission statement: The Center connects our creative community by providing a dedicated campus, supporting excellent programming, and nurturing a collaborative spirit. It is The Center's vision to make artistic experience central to Jackson Hole by embracing the values of stewardship, excellence, inclusion, creativity, and respect.

The Center is a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit organization. Any operating surplus is directed to operating costs, including depreciation.

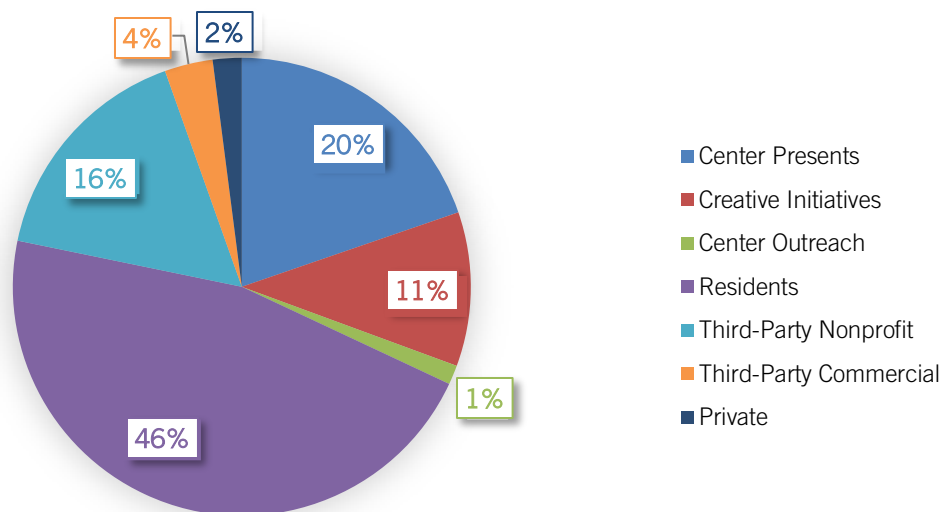

THE CENTER CAMPUS

- The Center was open 357 days.
- The Center Campus was used for 148 events over 119 days.
- The Center, through Creative Initiatives, Center Presents, and Center Outreach, hosted 47 events, which represents 33% of total events on campus.
- Residents hosted 68 events on campus, which represents 46% of total events.
- Third-party rentals, including nonprofit and for profit, accounted for 30 events, or 20% of overall campus usage. Of that, 24 events were Third-Party nonprofit, and 5 were Third-Party commercial. These separate categories represented 16% and 4% of total events, respectively.
- As per the conditions of The Center's lease with the Town and County, the total number of private profitable events may not exceed 10% of total events during the fiscal year. In 2018, one private profitable event was held on campus, representing 1% of total events on campus.
- The conditions of The Center's lease require that the total number of private profitable plus private non-profitable events not exceed 15% of total number of events. The Center hosted 1 private profitable event, and 2 private and non-profitable events, which represents 2% of all events on The Center Campus.
- The average ticket price for all events ticketed through The Center Box Office was \$38 (excluding free events and The Center's Annual Benefit).
- 21,931 tickets were sold through The Center Box Office in 2018.
- The Center Theater seats 525 people.
- The Center Theater Lobby is 2500 sq. ft.

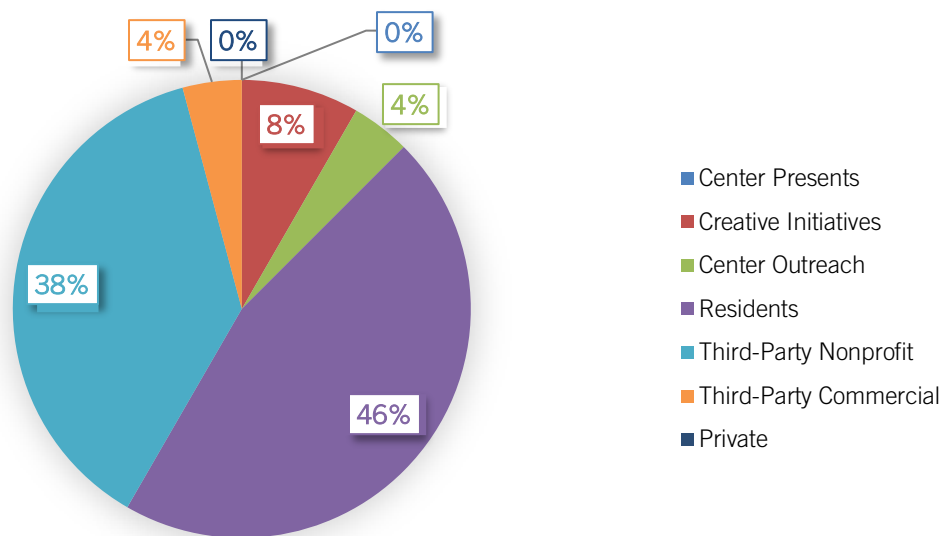

CENTER RESIDENT LEASE RATES

The 2018 annual lease rate for 1-year leaseholders was \$23.69 per built square foot for administrative space, \$16.17 per built square foot for studio and classroom space, and \$7.84 per built square foot for storage space.

In 2014, Residents were given the option of a 5-year lease term. If Residents opted for the 5-year lease term, their lease rates increased 10% during the first year, and CPI plus 1% during the subsequent years. The 2018 annual lease rates for Residents who exercised this option in 2015 are as follows: \$22.88 per built square foot for administrative space and \$7.53 per built square foot for storage space. Rates for Residents who exercised this option in 2016 are as follows: \$23.32 per built square foot for administrative space, \$16.10 per built square foot for studio and classroom space, and \$7.68 per built square foot for storage space.

Residents occupy and rent 30,391 square feet of The Center. Residents pay on average \$17.48 per square foot for occupied space. Additionally, Residents have access to roughly 25,753 square feet of common areas. Common areas do not include the theater, lobby, dressing rooms, costume shop, and music rooms. When common areas are factored into the overall square footage available, Residents' rates average \$9.46 per square foot.

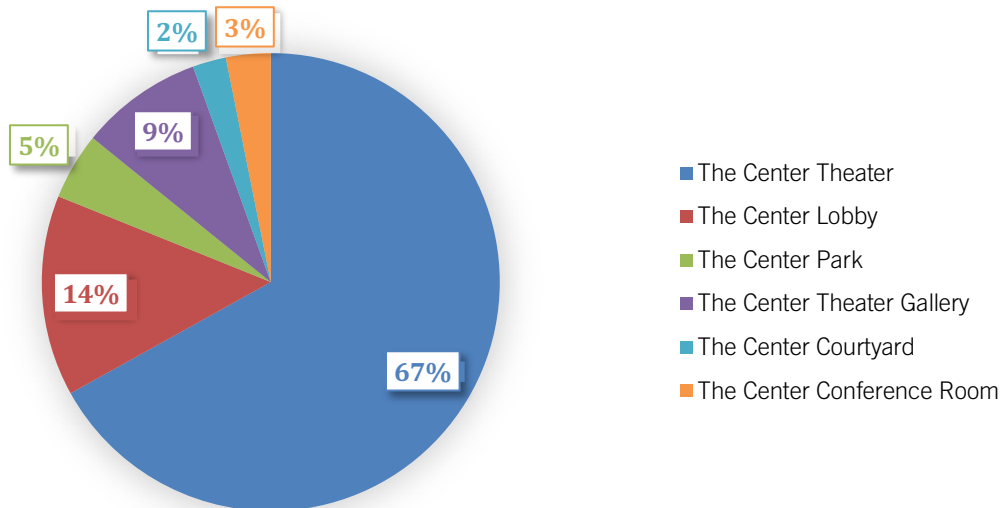

- Center Presents produced 29 performances and events.
- 101 volunteers supported The Center, for a total of 3,480 hours.
- The average median ticket price for Center Presents events was \$46 (excluding The Center's Annual Benefit).
- Spaces maintained and operated by The Center were used for 127 events.
- Of those events, 85 were in The Center Theater, 18 were in The Center Lobby, 6 were in The Center Park, 11 were in The Center Theater Gallery, 3 were in The Center Courtyard, and 4 were in The Center Conference Room.

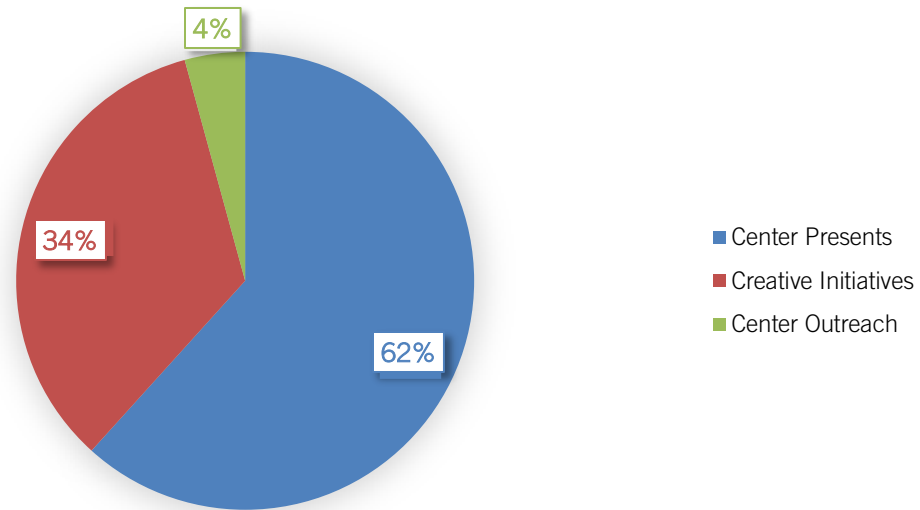
CENTER SPACE EVENT USAGE



THE CENTER PROGRAMMING

In 2018, The Center hosted 47 events. Of these events, 29 were produced by Center Presents, 16 were produced by Creative Initiatives, and 2 were produced by Center Outreach. Center Outreach is a new event category this year, which we created in order to represent those events not hosted by Center Presents or Creative Initiatives, but still put on by The Center. Center Outreach events are free events intended to strengthen The Center's connection with both Residents and the community as a whole. 18 of the events hosted by The Center were free (put on by Creative Initiatives and Center Outreach). The average ticket price for Center Presents events in 2018 was \$49, excluding the Annual Center Benefit.

THE CENTER'S FINANCES

THE CENTER FUNDRAISING HISTORY

Early efforts to build The Center began in the late 1990's. The Center was constructed in two phases; the Arts and Educational Pavilion opened in 2005, and The Center Theater opened in 2007.

To build each wing, The Center was successful in raising \$31.1M in gifts and pledges. \$12M for the education wing and \$18.1M for the theater. Several of these major gifts were pledged over multiple years, however, and during the second phase in 2007 it was necessary to borrow \$6.7M to meet short-term obligations. Most of the multi-year gifts received eliminated \$4.7M of the \$6.7M debt. Unfortunately, due to the economic recession in 2008, several major pledges were either reduced or cancelled. Because of this, The Center was unable to repay the loan in full and was left with \$2.5M in debt. In 2014 a concerted effort was launched to pay it down and just \$825,000 remains.

The Center has raised substantial monies to fund our operations. Lease income from Residents and Third-Party rental fees fall short of meeting our budgetary needs. Contributed income is essential to sustaining our financial health. To date, we have raised \$38,957,651 as outlined below.

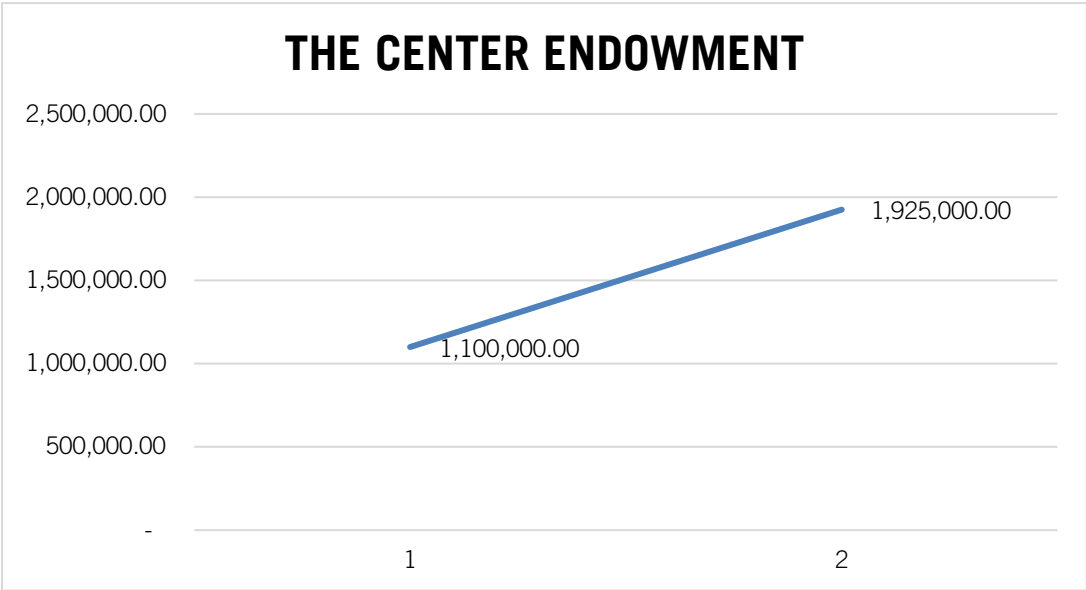

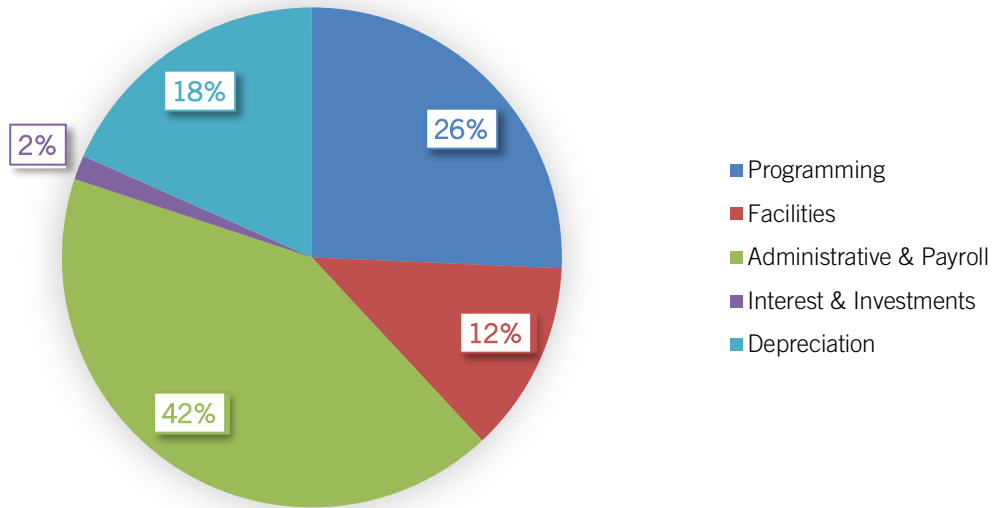
The Center Endowment effort began in 2017. In 2018, the Endowment experienced 48% growth.

SUMMARY OF CAPITAL DEBT

Every year, The Center makes a concerted effort to pay down our capital debt. To date, the debt has been reduced to \$825,000 from its high of \$6.7M.

In 2018, The Center did not receive any complaints from neighboring property owners.
